

## COVID-19 Emergency Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) Program

The COVID-19 TBRA Program will provide emergency rental assistance to City of Tulare residents facing financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eligible households will receive emergency rental assistance through December 31, 2020.

At a minimum, qualified applicants must meet the following:

- a. The current household income is at or below 60% of the Tulare County Median Income shown Below:

Income Category:	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
60%	\$29,400	\$33,600	\$37,800	\$41,940	\$45,300	\$48,660	\$52,020	\$55,380

- b. The household income or wages were reduced due to COVID-19
- c. Must have an outstanding rental balance through at least July 1, 2020

By providing the required pre-screening information, applicants will be able to determine if they meet the minimum eligibility criteria to continue with the final screening process.
